Qualifications: The Committee shall consist of: one (1) representative from each

Commissioners' district; one (1) representative from each of the following veterans' organizations, with that representative being the Commander of the organization or his/her designee: Ernest F. Hart American Legion Post 90 in Oxford, Moses S. Cash American Legion Post 161 in Creedmoor, Hester-Crews American Legion Post 166 in Oxford, Butner-Creedmoor VFW Post 10777 in Butner; one (1) representative that is a female veteran and one (1) representative that is a spouse of a veteran. An at-large position was appointed at the October 5, 2015 Board of Commissioners

Meeting for a two (2) year term.

Length of Term: Each member shall be appointed to a two year term. To establish

the committee the members from Districts 1,3,5 and 7 and the female veteran member shall be appointed to a two (2) year term, members from Districts 2,4 and 6 and the spouse of a veteran member shall be appointed to a one (1) year term. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for a two (2) year term. The representatives from the designated veterans' organizations shall be a permanent

seat.

Meeting Schedule: The Committee shall meet to organize within one month of

appointment. Thereafter, it shall meet on the 3rd Tuesday of every other month with the first meeting in January at 7:00 PM in the Meeting Room of the Granville County Expo and Convention
