## **Recent drug arrests reported by Granville County Sheriff's Office Special Operations Division**

**OXFORD, NC:** The Granville County Sheriff's Office's Special Operations Division reports the following drug arrests on August 26, 2021:

- A brief pursuit led to the arrest of Dewondo Devon Carroll of 309A Front Street in Oxford after he failed to stop for blue lights and sirens. After abandoning the vehicle and fleeing on foot, he was apprehended. Seized were 37 dosage units of heroin, 2.5 grams of crack cocaine and 6 grams of marijuana. Carroll was charged with fleeing/eluding arrest with a motor vehicle (felony); possession with intent to manufacture, sell and/or deliver heroin; possession with intent to manufacture, sell and/or deliver a schedule II controlled substance; possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia; and injury to personal property. He was issued a \$60,000 secured bond.
- Jartavious Lamar Daniels of 144 N. Shank Street in Henderson was arrested during an attempted delivery of heroin at the Citgo convenience store, 4111 US Hwy. 158 in Oxford. A search of his vehicle led to the recovery and seizure of approximately 77 dosage units of heroin, 30+ ecstasy pills, .9 grams of powder cocaine and 1.1 ounces of marijuana. Daniels was arrested and charged with possession with intent to manufacture, sell and/or deliver heroin; possession with intent to manufacture, sell and/or deliver a schedule I controlled substance; felony possession of cocaine; possession of marijuana (up to an ounce and a half); maintaining a vehicle for the purpose of keeping and/or selling a controlled substance (felony); and possession of drug paraphernalia. A \$55,000 secured bond was issued.
- Malek Perry of South Vance Drive in Henderson was arrested after the attempted delivery of heroin at 116 Granville Corners in Oxford. A search of the vehicle resulted in the discovery and seizure of approximately 171 dosage units of heroin. Perry was charged with possession with intent to manufacture, sell and/or deliver heroin; maintaining a vehicle for the purpose of keeping and/or selling controlled substances (felony); and possession of drug paraphernalia. He was issued a \$30,000 secured bond.
